

KREBS ORDINANCE NO. 15-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KREBS, OKLAHOMA.  
UNLAWFUL RECONNECTION OF KREBS UTILITY AUTHORITY SERVICE AFTER  
CUTOFF; REPEALING ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES, PROVIDING FOR A  
SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF JANUARY 20,  
2015.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
KREBS, OKLAHOMA**

Unlawful reconnection of service after cutoff:

When water has been shut off from any premises by application of the owner thereof or for the nonpayment of water charges or for any other cause, it shall be unlawful for any person again to connect such premises with water except when authorized to do so by the superintendent of utilities. When water is turned off by the city and the city discovers water is on at the residence without the cities or superintendent’s authority, a fee of \$100.00 will be charged to the homeowner or applicant. In addition if water is so turned on without such authority, the superintendent may then shut off the water at the main or remove a portion of the service connection at the cock, and if the water was so turned on by the consumer or by his authority, he shall be charged \$100.00 for reinstallation of the meter. Each day or part of a day during which such violation is continued or repeated shall constitute a separate offense. These fees are in addition to any other penalties for violation of code or legal offenses.
