SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
August 2, 2018

1. Mayor Bobby Watkins called the meeting to order.
2. Julia Casey Interim City Clerk called the roll. Bobby Watkins – Present, Tommy Walker – Present, Connie Poole – Present, Jason Wagnon – Present, Daulfin Bennett – Absent.
3. BUSINESS
 - A. CONSIDER AND ACT TO PURCHASE 2017 DODGE CHARGER POLICE SEDAN IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,068.50 FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT. Chief Cook addressed the council. Chief Cook says should say 2018 instead of 2017, but during the process they are out of 2018's. There are no 18's on state bid at all, so it will have to be a 2019. Dealership did say if council approves will give it to us for the 2018 cost, even though they will go up because of the import tax, it will still be given to us at the 2018 cost. Chief would like to replace the 2013 which is Courtney's car that they have been having problems with and currently it is not running. He states actually has 3 not running, a 2011, 2012 and 2013. He states down 1 vehicle he can't get it running and had Mark Moy come look at it. Mr. Moy thinks it is a tork converter on the transmission, but doesn't know why won't start. Chief has red tagged it and is parked behind police station. Mayor Watkins asked for any discussion. Tommy Walker asked how many do we have running. Chief replied 5. Tommy verified 5 running and 3 not. Chief agreed. Tommy asked if we were selling all of them. Chief states would like to surplus the 2012, 2011 and 2013 and sell. Tommy asked if the ones working were 2014 & 2015's. Chief replied yes. Chief states they used to buy 2 at a time, then we got to a point where we'd buy 1 at a time then we skipped a couple of years because of the budget. He states we are just behind on getting vehicles. Says he hopes to be considered for the purchase of this 2019 Dodge Sedan. Have to have it striped and what he would like to do is take all the equipment out of car and not update because we do not have the money to update equipment right now. We will take equipment out of all 3 cars that are not running and combine for new car to make it work. He states there will be some cost on that as well. Tommy asked if there was a color called police blue, a certain blue police officers paint car. Chief replied no. Mayor Watkins asked for a motion. Connie Poole made a motion. Jason Wagnon seconded. Mayor Watkins called for a vote. Jason Wagnon – yes, Connie Poole – yes, Tommy Walker – yes. Motion passes.
 - B. CONSIDER AND ACT TO PURCHASE IN-CAR CAMERA SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5713.00 FOR NEW POLICE CAR ABOVE. Chief Cook addressed the council. Chief Cook states during this phase he discovered that the old camera system won't fit in 2019 car. Camera is 5 ½ years old now. Like computers they become obsolete and needs to be updated. He would like the council to consider the purchase and he added that there is an I.T. fund that this qualifies for. Chairman Watkins asked for any discussion. There was none. Chairman Watkins asked for a motion. Connie Poole made a motion. Jason Wagnon seconded. Chairman Watkins called for a vote. Jason Wagnon – yes, Connie Poole – yes, Tommy Walker – yes as long as it comes out of the I.T. Fund. Motion passes.
