5. FINANCIAL REVIEW WITH MIKE KERN

Mike Kern you should all have a copy of the financial statement. We need to look at the income statement for Krebs Public works authority for the month of July. For the month of July our total revenues were \$113,620.36 Our operating expenses were \$(unable to hear due to background noise) we had an operating income of \$5,506.63, but we did have to transfer \$19,000.00 over to the general fund instead of transferring from the general fund to the KUA like we have in the past. This was a situation where general fund needed money transferred so the transfer was made so the operations within the KUA were on a positive note. Revenues are right on line with the budget. I put budget numbers in there because I wanted to, they are proposed budget but we are going to vote on approving the budget on the agenda here today. Again, the revenues for the average looks good the thing again that I' m looking at on the budget, we do have the rate increases that we usually put into effect in January. that should help generate some new revenues we are off to a good start in the KUA compared to where we have been that's good news. The other thing I want to keep pointing out the city ought to be very very very proud we only got, when we talked about it before over on the balance sheet on page two on the liability the notes payable for the current rural development is \$56,909. The long-term portion is &15,349 we will have those notes paid off in June of this year. That's tremendous. It will may be a big difference in what we are trying to get funding for water department and all that kind of stuff. So, we've made some process. Any comments or questions?

So, we've got to put money back into the KUA the cost of the chemicals cost of pipe, all that stuff is always going up and we just raised all our people last year so we need to generate some new revenue and the thing I based on mere calculating that would generate and extra \$20,000 that I hadn't even put on the budget. So that should help us out.
