1. Bobby Watkins, Mayor calls the meeting to order.
2. Jessica Green, City Clerk calls roll. Bobby Watkins-present, Tommy Walker-present, Connie Poole-present, Jason Wagnon-present, Daulfin Bennett-present.
3. CONSIDER AND ACT TO ADOPT COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS AND PREPARATIONS.
Daulfin Bennett states what if they are abiding the law and eating in separate dining rooms. Bobby Watkins states that we have to sale it to go. Liz Prichard, Kathy & Katie Prichard address the council and states that Governors Stitt has not shut everyone down. She states that they are following all guidelines and sanitizing everything. 4. CONSIDER AND ACT TO ENACT AN EMERGENCY CLAUSE.
As of March 22, 2020, at 11:59 PM, all restaurants and coffee shops are prohibited and can only do take out or delivery. Also, bars, gyms, fitness centers, recreation centers, and other similar facilities will be closed. This will be in effect for 48 hours, ending on March 24, 2020 at 11:59 PM. Mayor Watkins asks for a motion. Tommy Walker makes the motion. Connie Poole seconds the motion. Mayor Watkins calls for a vote. Tommy Walker-yes, Connie Poole-yes, Jason Wagnon-yes, Daulfin Bennett-yes. Motion passes.

5. COMMENTS FROM THE COUNCIL AND MAYOR

Connie states that they really appreciate and proud of the restaurants in Krebs. And want all of them to be here for another 100 years.
