## ORDINANCE NO. 22-07

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNUL, VACATE, DISCONTINUE AND CLOSE THAT PART OF 17<sup>TH</sup> AND 18<sup>TH</sup> STREET OF MORRIS AND CRISLER IN TOWN OF KREBS, PITTSBURG COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KREBS, OKLAHOMA, THAT:

SECTION 1: It shall be and is hereby declared necessary and expedient to close to the public and discontinue the following right-of-way, more particularly described as:

That part of 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> Street of Morris and Crisler in town of Krebs, Pittsburg County, State of Oklahoma. According to the official plat thereof, and that the same shall revert to the property owner(s) of the real estate adjacent thereto as provided by law, subject to any existing easements for all public utilities, including drainage, sewer, water, lights, gas or telephone and television cable lines.

SECTION 2: That this is hereby declared to exist, and for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, by reason whereof it is necessary that this act take effect and be in full force and effect from, and after the passage and approval.
